MISS LIVERETTE JOHNSON

Miss Liverette Johnson, a resident of this [sic] for about sixty years, died at her home on West Main St., Tuesday evening shortly after six o'clock. She was eighty-nine years of age last October and up until this winter has been very well and active. She was a great out-of-doors lady, and could be seen on early summer mornings busying herself about the lawn and garden, more after the manner of one decades younger.

She was the daughter of Simon and Amy Chamberlain Johnson and was born in the town of Allen. Her parents were early pioneers in this section and often related tales to her of the Indians and the wolves.

The funeral will be held from the residence Friday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock and will be conducted by Rev. Clara E. Morgan of the Universalist church of Perry, N.Y. Interment will be at Maple Grove cemetery.
