MARY S. JOHNSON,

Wife of ex-Supervisor William W. Johnson of Royalton, died Monday, Aug. 8, 1898, at 10 o'clock a.m., aged 50 years and 11 months.

She had been sick since April last with cancer of the breast, which at last caused her death. She leaves, besides her husband, two daughters, Mrs. Belle E. Smith of Medina and Miss Mary J. Johnson at home; also her mother, Mrs. Eliza Wesley of Akron, N.Y.

The deceased was possessed of many noble qualities which made her esteemed by those who knew her. She was a kind, loving and devoted wife and mother and her death is deeply mourned by relatives and friends.

Mrs. Johnson came from Erie county with her husband 29 years ago and settled upon the place in Royalton where she thereafter resided during the remainder of her life. At the last she realized that her days upon this earth were few, and she made all preparations for her funeral. Her instructions were earnestly complied with. The funeral services were conducted at the house, the Rev. [Glenn W.] Kratzer of Middleport officiating, on August 10th, at 2 p.m. The attendance at the services was very large. The bearers were Fred Fink, J. W. Williams, J. M. Williams, Joseph Theilk, C. F. Webber, Geo. Arnold. The choir of West Shelby church sang appropriate selections. The interment was in the family lot at the Cemetery in West Shelby.
