SANFORD H. JOHNSON
Successfully Followed Farming in Town of Herkimer for Many Years

Fort Plain, May 22—Sanford H. Johnson, aged 76 years, died yesterday at his home in this village, following a long illness. Mr. Johnson had been in poor health for several years and death was not a surprise to his friends and relatives. He was born in Herkimer County and lived there for many years, where he was a most successful farmer. Several years ago he retired and came to Fort Plain, where he had since made his home. He was quite well known and had a host of friends who will regret his death. Besides his widow the deceased is by one son, Lester Johnson of Fort Plain and two daughters, Mrs. Edgar [Ora] Mesick of Fort Plain and Mrs. George [Grace] Bellinger of Danube; also several grandchildren. The funeral will be held from the late home Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert Frank Moulton, D.D., pastor of the Universalist Church, officiating. The interment will be made in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
