William Johnson, Former Royalton Supervisor, Dies

Middleport, June 21.—William W. Johnson died Wednesday morning at his late home, No. 19 Francis street. He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Belle E. Smith of Medina, and Miss Mary A. Johnson at home; a grandson, two great grandchildren and five nephews, four of whom reside in the West and one, James B. Johnson, at Akron.

Mr. Johnson was born February 6, 1841, in the town of Newstead, Erie County. He resided in the town of Royalton the past 59 years, of which 21 years he was a resident of Middleport. His wife, Mary S. Johnson, died August 8, 1898.

In politics he was a Democrat, and served as supervisor and commissioner of highways of the Town of Royalton. At the time of his death he was president of Mt. Pleasant Cemetery Association, West Shelby.

The funeral will be held on Friday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, standard time, from the late home, with burial at Mt. Pleasant Cemetery. The Rev. C. [Clarence] J. Cowing [Universalist] will officiate.
