BAND MOURNS A MEMBER
Delevan Jones Succumbs at Thanksgiving Hospital Monday

Delevan Jones of Oaksville died at Thanksgiving Hospital in this village Monday evening, July 6th, after a brief illness with pneumonia which developed after an operation on Sunday. Mr. Jones was well known throughout the county as one of the proprietors of the sawmill at Oaksville, as a musician and a gentleman. For many years he was a member of various Cooperstown musical organizations including the band and Bronner's orchestra.

He was born in Schuyler Lake forty-two years ago and has resided at Oaksville for the past fifteen years. Surviving him are his wife, two daughters Harriet and Marguerite, one son Robert, his father Richard Jones of Schuyler Lake, and one brother John Jones who also resides in that village.

The funeral will be held from his late home Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. W. G. Cortright of the Cooperstown Universalist church officiating, with interment at Fly Creek.
