Mrs. Sheldon Jones Passes Suddenly

Little Falls, Sept. 15—Eunice Cheney, wife of Sheldon E. Jones, 72 North Ann Street, this city, died this evening at Saltman's Hotel, Ephratah, following a stroke of paralysis. Mr. and Mrs. Jones and immediate family had motored to the hotel for dinner. A physician from Canajoharie was summoned.

Mrs. Jones was born in the town of Fly Creek, Otsego County, in 1849, daughter of Henry and Lucretia Garlick Cheney of Fly Creek. She came to this place as a young girl with her parents. Her father, Henry Cheney, founded the Henry Cheney Hammer Company, which is still in operation here, removing the plant here from Fly Creek.

She married Mr. Jones, February 12, 1869. They celebrated the 60th anniversary of their marriage last February. The deceased was a member of Aetenrogen Chapter, D.A.R. and an attendant at the Universalist Church in this city.

Surviving besides her husband are one son, Henry C. Jones, of this city. She also leaves three grandchildren, George S. Jones, Mrs. Harold Barnes and Henry C. Jones, Jr., all of this city; one great-granddaughter, Eunice Cornelia Jones, Little Falls, and one sister, Mrs. Jay S. Newell, of Church Street.
