Christmas day was saddened at the home of Mr. and Mrs. John F. Jones of Cassville, by the death of their son, George T. Jones, aged 26 years, which followed an illness of only four days with pneumonia. Mr. Jones was born in Exeter, June 4, 1890. He lived [there] until he was 10 years old, when the family moved to West Winfield. After eight years in that village the family moved to North Bridgewater. Four weeks ago they bought a home in Cassville. The young man was united in marriage with Harriet M. Roberts, December 15, 1911, and he survived her four years. He had earned the esteem of all who knew him by his industry and true manly character. His death is sincerely mourned and deep sympathy of all is extended to the parents and a brother and sister, Ellis H. Jones of Bridgewater and Florence A. Jones of Cassville. The funeral will be held at the parents' home, this afternoon at 1 o'clock.
