VICTIM OF PTOMAININE POISONING  
Sad Death of An Esteemed Young Resident of Bridgewater

A (?) of youthful life came to an end in the death of Harriet Roberts, wife of George T. Jones, of Bridgewater, which occurred recently in that village as a result of ptomaine poisoning. Mr. and Mrs. Jones were taken suddenly ill after partaking of food and a doctor was summoned. The latter pronounced ptomaine poisoning as the trouble. Mr. Jones rallied, but his wife grew worse until her death two days later.

Mrs. Jones was the only daughter of Mrs. Grace Roberts, who lives near Cassville, and was born in Bridgewater 18 years ago. She married Mr. Jones a year ago last December. Her death is a blow to her numerous friends in the community in which she resided. The funeral was held from the home of her husband's parents in Bridgewater, Rev. DeWitt Lamphear, of the Universalist Church, officiating. Interment was made in Fairview Cemetery at Bridgewater.
