Death resulted from duodenal ulcer and hemorrhages. Deceased had been in poor health for some time but of late his condition had been critical. He had lived here about 12 years and was widely known. He was employed at the M. F. Smith & Son store. His death is the cause of much genuine sorrow in the city.

Besides his wife he leaves to mourn his loss, one son, Lawrence; one sister, Mrs. Cora Collver and one brother, L. C. Jones of Whitesville; and another brother Archibald Jones of Lansing, Mich.

The funeral was held from the home in Hornell, Tuesday and later from the Universalist church in Whitesville with burial in Rural Cemetery, Rev. R. S. Kellerman [Universalist] officiating.

John Jones was born on the homestead on the Cryder Creek road and spent over forty years of his life there and in this village, finally moving to Hornell as stated above.

He was a quiet, home-loving man, who had the respect of all who knew him and his passing is genuinely lamented in this section.
