JOHN ADELBERT JONES

John Adelbert Jones, 88, of Schuyler Lake, died in his home Tuesday afternoon of last week after a long illness.

Mr. Jones was born February 18, 1865, at Clayville, son of Richard and Mary Elizabeth (Haigh) Jones, and married Angie V. Baker on December 30, 1890, at Schuyler Lake. Both were natives and lifelong residents of Schuyler lake. She died January 11, 1948.

Mr. Jones was a blacksmith and in later years was in the feed business. He was a member of Schuyler Lake Universalist Church, Schuyler Lake Lodge 162, F. & A.M., a trustee of Schuyler Lake Cemetery, a trustee of Schuyler Lake Masonic Lodge, and Schuyler Lake volunteer fire department.

Surviving him are two nieces, Mrs. Marguerite Rathbun and Mrs. Harriet Sheldon, and a nephew, Robert P. Jones. Services are in charge of the Ingalls Funeral Home of Cooperstown.

The funeral was in the home at 2:30 p.m. Friday, with the Rev. Stanley Stall of Schuyler Lake Universalist Church, officiating. Burial was in Schuyler Lake Cemetery.
