The death of Mrs. Lina D. Jones, widow of Delevan L. Jones, occurred Thursday afternoon at her home in Oaksville after several months of ill health. She rallied from a serious operation ten weeks ago in the Fox Memorial Hospital, Oneonta, and returned to her home about four weeks ago. Since that time, her decline has been rapid.
