MRS. SUSAN JONES DIES AT 77 IN ROCHESTER

Mrs. Susan Jones, one of Webster's most prominent women, passed away in Rochester Thursday (Dec. 13, 1945) at the age of 77.

Well known in musical circles and always in demand as a piano accompanist, Mrs. Jones for over 35 years kindly and generously answered the call of local organizations. She also taught piano lessons.

Her husband, Frank F. Jones, a former supervisor of the Town of Webster, died in 1939.

Mrs. Jones was a charter member of the local Order of Eastern Star and was matron in 1909. She was a member of the Universalist Church where she was organist and choir director for many years.

Mr. and Mrs. Jones at one time operated a restaurant in the present Legion building.

Surviving are: one daughter, Mrs. Abel of Webster; two brothers, Thomas E. Wright of Webster and Clarence G. of Rochester; also three grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at the Smith & Lotze Funeral Home Saturday at 2:30 p.m. Burial was in Union Hill Cemetery.
