MRS. FRANK JORDAN EXPIRES IN MOHAWK

Mohawk—Mrs. Imogene M. Jordan, 71, wife of Frank A. Jordan, died last night, Sept. 9, 1936, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. George A. Anderson, this village.

She was born June 26, 1863, at Boston, Mass., daughter of the late Abner and Lovey Gilbert Haven, and was married to Mr. Jordan more than 56 years ago and together they conducted for many years the Jordan Laundry in Herkimer. They sold the business about a year ago and have since resided in Mohawk.

Mrs. Jordan was a member of the Herkimer Universalist Church and its Ladies Aid Society.

Besides her husband, she leaves two sons, Gilbert, East Herkimer, Roland, Plattsburgh; a daughter, Mrs. Anderson, Mohawk; a sister, Mrs. Ida Conner, Massachusetts; four grandchildren, Mrs. Morris Blackman, Utica, Doris Elaine, Plattsburg, Joan and Gilbert Jordan 2nd, East Herkimer.
