Charles Kane, (better known as Bob Kane), aged about 63, died at the home of his sister, Mrs. Helen Lintner, in Valley Brook last Friday evening. Following a stroke, he had been in poor health for a number of years and death must have been a relief from his suffering and helplessness. Up to the time he was stricken Mr. Kane was a powerful man physically and an expert bridge erector. His sister, Mrs. Lintner, with whom he lived, survives. The funeral was held at the home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. H. F. [Herbert Frank] Moulton, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. The body was placed in the Catharine Nellis Memorial vault and burial will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery in the spring.
