Frank H. Keller died at his home in Richfield Springs Tuesday morning, August second after many years of illness. For a long period he was a victim of locomotor ataxia, and during the last few month Bright's disease developed. He was born in Oppenheim, Herkimer county, in 1854; and came here as a boy, where he passed the rest of his life. In Richfield's heyday he was proprietor of a large and well-equipped livery. He was always an enthusiastic supporter of any plan or measure for home improvements, and ready with voice and money to forward a bettering project. He leaves also, sisters Emma and Alice of New York, and Ella and Bertha of Isle of Pines; brothers, Starr of Isle of Pines, and Ward of New York. The funeral will be held Thursday afternoon at 3:30.
