Miss Jennie Kelsey

Fort Plain, May 11.—The remains of Miss Jennie Kelsey of New York city, formerly of this village, were brought here Tuesday afternoon and the funeral services held in the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel at 3 o'clock, the Rev. Dr. Henry B. Taylor, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. Miss Kelsey was a daughter of the late Peter and Helen Kelsey of Fort Plain and was a resident of this village up until about 25 years ago, when she and her sister, Miss Grace Kelsey, moved to New York. She was a member of the Fort Plain chapter, D.A.R., and the Universalist church. Miss Kelsey was a direct descendant of General George Nellis, Peter Ehle and Francis Lighthall, all Revolutionary residents of the Mohawk valley. She is survived by one brother, Attorney Frank G. Kelsey, of Camden, N.Y.; two sisters, Mrs. Helen Belsey of Peoria, Ill., and Miss Grace Kelsey of New York city.
