Obituary.

Mrs. Tryphena Kent, widow of Remember Kent, died quite suddenly last Saturday at the residence of her sister, Mrs. W. H. Tufts, on James street, in this city. She was apparently usually well in the morning, and was assisting in doing some work about 8 A.M., when she fell upon the floor. In spite of all that could be done by the physicians which were summoned, Mrs. Kent died on Saturday evening. She was about 72 years of age, and had lived in Rome many years. The funeral ceremonies took place yesterday at Mrs. Tufts' residence. To-day the remains were taken to West Leyden, Lewis county, for interment.

—When the late Remember Kent died he left considerable property, which his widow was to have the use of during her lifetime. At her death the property remaining after paying certain bequests amounting to some \$3,500, was to go to the Universalist Church of this city. Mrs. Kent died last Saturday, as stated elsewhere, and it is now expected that the church [will] receive quite a benefit.
