Franklin I. Ketcham

The death of Franklin I. Ketcham occurred at his late home, one mile south of Bushnell's Basin, Saturday evening, November 29th. His illness was of eight days duration. Bronchial pneumonia was the cause of his death. He was born February 23, 1854, on the farm where he died. He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. John [and Alma Tedman] Ketcham. His farm had been the home of three generations of Ketchams. Mr. Ketcham was highly respected by all who knew him. He served the town of Perinton two years as justice of the peace. None knew him but to speak well of him.

Surviving relatives are his wife, Minnie Boughton Ketcham; one son, George, who resides at the family home; two sisters, Mrs. Belle Foote of Somerset, N.Y., and Mrs. Lottie Rowley of Detroit, Mich.; an adopted sister, Miss Etta Ketcham of Niagara Falls; four nephews, Glenn and Harry Foote of Niagara county, [and] Truman and Earl Ketcham of Waterbury, Conn. Funeral services were held at the home Tuesday afternoon, Rev. E. [Edwin] P. Wood of the Universalist church of Victor, officiating. Interment in Pittsford.
