HEART DISEASE KILLED KEYES

Property from Which He Had Income Goes to Universalist Church.

Coroner A. J. Forman, after investigating into the circumstances of the death of Lewis W. Keyes, who was found dead in bed in his home, No. 27 Van Anden Street yesterday by his neighbor, Henry Ham, declared today that death was due to heart trouble. The funeral service will be held at the Tallman-Walker undertaking rooms on Clark Street on Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. The funeral arrangements are in charge of J. Lewis Grant, who has been executor of the estate of Miss Eliza W. Keyes, sister of the deceased. Burial will be made in Fort Hill Cemetery.

In the death of Mr. Keyes, a provision in the will of his sister becomes effective and certain real estate, the income of which has been turned over to Mr. Keyes as beneficiary of the will, will now become the possession of the First Universalist Church. The value of the property involved cannot be definitely fixed.

Rev. Arnold S. Yantis [pastor of the Universalist Church] will officiate at the funeral.
