MRS. LILLIAN KIBBE, 82, NATIVE OF STRATFORD

DOLGEVILLE—Mrs. Lillian Kibbe, 82, died Nov. 27, 1954 at the home of her son, Earl Kibbe, Stratford, after an illness of several months.

Mrs. Kibbe was born July 21, 1872 in Stratford, a daughter of Richard [and] Charity Bullock Rockwell. They lived in Stratford most of their lives, spending a couple of years in Ilion. She was a member of the Universalist Church of Dolgeville and a member of the Clara Barton Chapter of the church. She was married Jan. 28, 1890 to William Kibbe. He died about 13 years ago.

She leaves four daughters, Mrs. Paul Lyman, Mrs. Charles Hayes, Mrs. Ethel Deming, all of Ilion, and Mrs. Ernest Davis, Salisbury Center; three sons, Earl, Stratford, Drew, Ilion, [and] Jay, Mohawk; several grandchildren, several great grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral will be at 1 tomorrow from the home of Earl Kibbe, with the Rev. Gale Bascomb, Dolgeville Universalist Church, assisted by the Rev. Arthur Lacey, Baptist Church, officiating. Burial will be in Tuttle Cemetery, Town of Salisbury.
