DIES SUDDENLY

Middleport Woman Found Dead When Friends Call at Her Home.

MIDDLEPORT, June 15.—Miss Clara B. King, 71, well-known Middleport woman and formerly a painter of landscapes, was found dead at her North Hartland street home yesterday afternoon. Death was due to heart disease.

Miss King had attended church in the morning and was going for an auto ride yesterday afternoon with Mr. and Mrs. Frank Morrissey, neighbors. When she failed to respond to their ring they investigated and found her dead. She is survived only by two pieces [nieces] of Pennsylvania. The funeral arrangements have not been completed.
