MRS. MIRANDA KINNE

Mrs. Miranda Duguid Kinne, widow of Royal W. Kinne, died on Saturday evening at her home in Corfu, death resulting from the infirmities of age. She was confined to her bed only ten days and retained her mental faculties until the last, notwithstanding her advanced age of 87 years.

Mrs. Kinne's maiden name was Miranda Duguid and she was a daughter of the late Jason and Achsah Halbert Duguid, who were among the early settlers of this county. She was born on the Duguid homestead at Bailey's Mills in the town of Pavilion on March 24, 1832, and resided there until her marriage to Mr. Kinne on November 17, 1864, since which time her home had been in Corfu. She was a member of the Universalist church and a charter member of Corfu Grange. Mr. Kinne died in 1900.

Mrs. Kinne is survived by one sister, Mrs. Sarah Pinney of Roanoke and three brothers, William H. Duguid, of Corfu, Nelson A. Duguid, of Roanoke and Manfred Duguid of LeRoy. She also leaves the following grandchildren: Supervisor R. A. Kinne, of Corfu; Mrs. Clara Payne, of Champaign, Il.; Mrs. Constance Grazier, of Woodlawn, Cal.; Mrs. George H. Phelps and Roy K. Duguid, of Buffalo.

The funeral was held yesterday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the house in Corfu, Rev. Harry Wright of Rochester officiating, and the interment was made in Evergreen Hill cemetery, Corfu.
