Services Held Tuesday For William F. Kip, 89

Funeral services for William F. Kip, 89, native of Canton, were held Tuesday afternoon from the Lawrence Funeral Home with Rev. Theodore Webb, pastor of the Universalist Church, officiating. Burial was made in Evergreen cemetery.

Mr. Kip died Sunday afternoon at the Barlow Nursing Home where he had been a patient for three days.

He was born in Canton, March 13, 1865, a son of Henry D. and Harriet Ball Kip. He attended local schools and after graduation, until 1898, he was employed as a foreman in the Rushton Boat company here.

In 1898 Mr. Kip went to New York and became associated with the Geigy company, which manufactured industrial dies. He returned in 1931, holding the position of executive secretary of the firm. He returned to Canton at that time and has made his home here ever since.

He was a member of the Canton Universalist church; Canton Lions Club, Stillwater Club, and was a charter member and one of the founders of the Canton Club.

Mr. Kip is survived by a brother, Benjamin Kip, and a niece, Miss Welthia Kip, both of Canton.
