MRS. ALICE KLOCK, WAS TEACHER

Fords Bush—Mrs. Alice Klock, 72, former teacher, died March 23, 1959, in her Fords Bush home after a long illness. She had lived in the same house 45 years.

She was born Oct. 31, 1886, in South Columbia, daughter of William and Emmer Dingman Hopkinson.

Miss Hopkinson taught in Crystal Springs and Hartwick before her marriage to Marcy Klock on June 30, 1920. He died Aug. 2, 1950.

Mrs. Klock was a member of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, Fort Plain.

She leaves a daughter, Miss Gertrude Klock of Brattleboro, Vt.; a son, Donald Klock of Fort Plain RD1; a brother, Olen Hopkinson of South Columbia; three grandchildren.

The funeral will be at 2 Friday from the Swartz Funeral Home, Fort Plain, the Rev. Raymond M. Scott, pastor of the Universalist Church, officiating. Burial will be in Fort Plain Cemetery.
