FORT PLAIN MAIN [sic] DIES IN AMSTERDAM HOSPITAL

FORT PLAIN, Aug. 13—Howard Klock, 52, died Tuesday in the Amsterdam City Hospital, where he was admitted as a patient Monday night.

Mr. Klock was born in Fort Plain April 8, 1891, the son of Stephen and Ella Smith Klock, and had always resided here. He was a member of the Universalist Church, Mohawk Valley Lodge, Knights of Pythias, American Legion Band and Fort Plain Band. He had been employed at the Remington Arms Co. in Ilion.

The survivors are his wife and one aunt, Mrs. Charles Melick, of Canajoharie. The Knights of Pythias conducted a service at the home Thursday night at 8 o'clock and the funeral was held at the home this afternoon at 2 o'clock. The Rev. W. A. Haney of the Universalist Church officiated. Burial was in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
