Stephen Klock

Stephen Klock, aged 69, died at his home on Webster street on Tuesday morning of a complication of diseases. He was born in the town of Minden on Nov. 8, 1857, the son of Archibald and Hannah Klock, and had been a lifelong resident of this section. He had been seriously ill since December. Prior to that time, Mr. Klock had been employed as a carpenter in the Bailey Knitting Mills. He was a member of the Universalist church and also a member of the Champion Hook and Ladder company.

Besides his wife [Ella Smith Klock], Mr. Klock is survived by a son, Howard Klock, of Fort Plain, and one brother, Marvin Klock, of Canajoharie.

The funeral will be held on Friday at 2 p.m. from the home, Rev. H. [Henry] B. Taylor officiating. Burial in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
