Andrew M. Knight, a respected and life long resident of Webster, died at his home on Lapam Park, Tuesday forenoon, aged seventy-seven years. He was born in this town, then a part of Penfield, February 28, 1831. His parents were Nathaniel and Mary Robb Knight. He was married January 2, 1859 [to Phebe Ann *Robb*]. He had followed the trade of carpenter all his life, excepting for a few years past. He had been blind for four years. He is survived by his wife and four [three] children: George L. of Lyons, Kan., Dayton R. of Auburn, Miss Nellie G. Knight, who is preceptress of the Webster Union school. Also three brothers: George, James and Will, all of this place. The funeral will be held Saturday at 2:30 from his late home, the pastor of the Universalist church officiating.
