Mrs. Phoebe A. Knight [Knight], widow of Andrew M Knight, died at her home in Lapham Park, Saturday evening, after a short illness. Mrs. Knight was the daughter of Franklin and Sarah Ann Robb, and was a life-long resident of Webster, having been born at the family home on the Phillips road, November 28, 1887. She had been a member of the Universalist church in this village since its organization in 1874.

Mrs. Knight leaves three children, two sons and one daughter, George L. of Boise, Idaho, Dayton R. of Auburn, N. Y., and Mary G., of Webster; two sisters, Sarah F. Robb of Utica, and Mrs. Marietta S. Phelps of Webster, one brother, Charles Robb, also of this village, and two children, Mildred and Stella Knight of Boise, Idaho. The funeral was held from her late home Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. Donald Frazer of the Universalist church, officiating. Interment in Webster Rural cemetery.
