Nellie M. Vernoy was born in Wolcott October 24, 1854, daughter of Joseph and Jane Rice Vernoy. Her father died while she was young and with her mother, she came to LaGrange, where their home was made with Mr. and Mrs. Allen Rice.

[On] January 27, 1876 she was united in marriage to D.S. Knowlton and for a few years of their early married life they resided on a farm near Pavilion. For several years they lived in LaGrange and about 45 years ago came to Perry where they built a home in Watkins Avenue.

Three daughters were born to Mr. and Mrs. Knowlton, Edna, the oldest, dying when she was about nine years old. The two surviving daughters, Miss Mable and Mrs. Porter [Maude] Davis [are] living in Perry. Mr. Knowlton died about five years ago [27 Feb 1931] and since that time she made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Davis, last fall opening her home at 59 Covington street, where she lived with her other daughter. She suffered a stroke in April, last year.

Attending the service from out of town were Mrs. Wm. Drury, Oswego; Mrs. Charles Morrow, Pavilion Center; John Cowie, Wyoming and Miss Louise Blanchard, of Cohocton.
