Mrs. T. J. Knowlton Dead

Mrs. Phoebe Stewart Knowlton died at her home at No. 24 Wood street at 3 o'clock Saturday morning, aged 81 years. She was the widow of Thaddeus J. Knowlton, to whom she was united in marriage on May 28th, 1845. They resided in Pavilion until 1885, when they removed to Batavia. Mr. Knowlton died on September 24th, 1896.

Mrs. Knowlton is survived by a son, D. S. [Daniel Stewart] Knowlton, of Perry; a daughter, Miss Eva F. Knowlton, of Batavia; two brothers, Hosea Stewart, of Campaign [Champaign], Ill., and Seneca B. Stewart, of Savoy, Ill., and three sisters, Mrs. Martha Wiseman, of Gainesville; Mrs. Elzada Keeney, of Kalamazoo, Mich., and Mrs. Catherine Kenyon, of St. Clair, Mich.
