Charles W. Krieger

A patient at the Littauer hospital since March 12, Charles W. Krieger, 48, of Rockwood, died there last night at 10.

A resident of Rockwood for the past six years, Mr. Krieger served as school bus driver of that area.

He was born in Brooklyn July 1, 1901, son of Karl and Anna (Ortlieb) Krieger, and had resided in Fulton County for 30 years. On October 26, 1930 he was married to Rose Clemons by the Rev. Clinton Moulton of the Dolgeville Universalist Church.

He was a member of Fort Johnson Aerie, F.O.E., 1875.

Survivors besides his wife are four daughters, Mrs. Frank Sammons of St. Johnsville R.D.-2, Mrs. Junior Allen of Conklingville, Mrs. Harry Flansburg of Johnstown R.D.-2 and Mrs. Glennis Blanchard of Rockwood; five grandchildren; three sisters, Mrs. Richard Brill of St. Johnsville, Mrs. Ernest Kraft of Fort Johnson and Mrs. Cornelius Stowell of Oppenheim; also a brother, Edward of St. Johnsville and several nieces and nephews.

The body was removed to the Cole funeral home to be prepared for burial. It will be returned to the family residence, where the funeral will be held Friday at 2 P.M. with the Rev. Moulton officiating.

Burial will be in the Dolgeville cemetery.
