

[Lamb, Truxton G.]

—Hon. Truxton G. Lamb, brother of E. H. Lamb, Esq., died Sunday evening at his home in Sherburne, aged 68. Mr. Lamb formerly lived in Columbus, and carried on the business of farming. He was a member of the Legislature in 1857-8, and took a large part in public affairs. The temperance cause found him a conspicuous and unceasing advocate. The Universalist church at Sherburne, and the denomination at large, owes much of its present prosperity to his earnest and judicious labors. At the time of his death he was President of the Board of Education of Sherburne, Superintendent of the Universalist Sunday school and one of the trustees of the Clinton Liberal Institute. The funeral took place Wednesday morning.
