50-YEAR RESIDENT DIES

Harold Lampman, 70, died Friday night at his Nelliston home, following a long illness.

Funeral services were to be held at 2 p.m. today at the Swartz funeral home with the Rev. Lyman Achenbach, pastor of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, officiating. Burial was to be in Fort Plain Cemetery.

A resident of Fort Plain for 50 years, he had been employed at Gilbert Mills and its predecessor, Bailey Knitting Mills.

Mr. Lampman, a member of the Universalist Church, was born in the Town of Canajoharie, May 14, 1882. He was a son of Ullman and Jennie Farley Lampman.
