ULLMAN LAMPMAN

FORT PLAIN, June 20.—The funeral of Ullman Lampman, aged 65 years, was held at his home in Nelliston this afternoon at 3 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert F. Moulton, D.D., pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. The interment was in the Fort Plain cemetery. Mr. Lampman was born in St. Johnsville and came to this village when a young man and lived here many years. In early life he was a mule spinner by occupation and during his work he lost several fingers while cleaning a machine while it was running. He was of a pleasant and genial disposition and had many friends who will regret his death. He had been in poor health for a long time and [his] death Saturday did not surprise his relatives and friends. Besides his widow [Jennie Farley Lampman], he is survived by one son, Harold T. Lampman, and a daughter, Mrs. Howard Lipe, both of Nelliston; also one sister, Mrs. Hattie Nellis of St. Johnsville.
