Obituary.

Mrs. Emeline A. Lance died at her home on Church street this morning at 6 o'clock, of pneumonia. She was sick about 10 days, and at one time her symptoms seemed somewhat favorable to her recovery, but a relapse followed and yesterday it was evident that she was sinking fast and would not live 24 hours. Mrs. Lance was 69 years old. Her maiden name was Angell and she was born in Little Falls about three miles from this village, on the Herkimer road. She was a sister of George Angell[,], trackmaster on the Cental road, and a half sister of S. J. Waters, Sr. Her husband was killed by a horse running away with him in Frankfort about 30 years ago. Mrs. Lance had passed most of the years of her life in Little Falls but had resided for a few years in Watertown. She leaves one son, George Lance, of Watertown, and two daughters, Mrs. Watt Evans, of Oneida, and Mrs. George Beebe, of Penn Yan. The funeral will be held from her late residence on Monday afternoon at 3 o'clock. Rev. R. E. [Richard Eddy] Sykes will officiate.
