## Mrs. Lane of Central Square Drops Dead

CENTRAL SQUARE, May 7.—Mrs. P. [Perrin] L. Lane dropped dead at ther home, Sunday morning. Mrs. Lane had been usually well and was about to dress for church, when her husband hearing her fall, rushed to her only to find her dying. Doctors Drake and Wilcox were summoned, but the heart had stopped before they could reach her. The whole community was shocked, and could scarcely believe that one who had been seen by so many only the evening before, seemingly in the best of health and spirits, could be dead.

Mrs. Lane<sup>1</sup> was the daughter of Mr. N. [Nelson] P. [and Caroline Barras] Eastwood, of Cicero, and her funeral will take place at the Universalist church in that place, Tuesday afternoon. Rev. Richmond Fiske, of Watertown, will officiate.

A large circle of relatives and friends mourn the loss of her who in all the relations of life seemed to delight not only in happiness for herself, but in making others happy also.
