William T. Lane, President of the Nassau Fire Insurance Company, at Court and Remsen Streets, Brooklyn, died yesterday at his home, in the Mansion House, Brooklyn Heights. He was sixty-five years old and was born in Brooklyn. He entered the employ of the Nassau Fire Insurance Company at an early age as a messenger and worked his way up to the head of the company.

He was a Lieutenant of Company B, Thirteenth Regiment, Brooklyn, in the civil war. Mr. Lane was Treasurer of the Thirteenth Regiment Veteran Association and a member of Grant Post, G.A.R. He was one of the organizers of the Fire Insurance Salvage Corps of Brooklyn, and was Treasurer of the corps. He was a member and at one time the President of the St. Nicholas Society of Nassau Island (Long Island). Mr. Lane was never married. The funeral services will be held in the Universalist Church of Our Father, Grand Avenue and Lefferts Place, to-morrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock.
