H. H. Larcher [sic] Dead at 75

ILION—Funeral services will be held at 2 P.M. today for Henry Holmes Larchar, 75, Town Clerk of the town of Columbus, who died Monday in his home in Columbus Center. He had been ill for the last 13 years.

He was born in Columbus, March 27, 1870, son of Orrin D. and Mary Ann Holmes Larchar. His childhood was spent in Columbus where he attended the local school. He also attended the Elmira Business College. He married Maud Hopson on Sept. 20, 1893.
