The funeral of the late A. J. Lawton was largely attended at the Universalist church on Sunday afternoon, Rev. Geo. Adams officiating. The deceased was a kind neighbor, a man of quiet and unobtrusive manners, and one of our most prosperous farmers. His illness, of about a week only, was the result of a cold, which soon assumed the form of pneumonia. The father of the deceased, aged 95 years, was in attendance at the funeral; three brothers and a brother-in-law served as bearers. The remains were interred in the Clinton cemetery.
