Ross LePard, Retired Area Farmer, Dies

MIDDLEPORT—Ross B. LePard, 74, died unexpectedly Thursday evening (Sept. 17, 1959) at his home, Freeman Red., Town of Royalton. He suffered a heart attack.

Mr. LePard, born in the Town of Newstead, Erie County, on Jan. 26, 1885, was the son of John and Rebecca Barnhard LePard. A retired farmer, he spent his winters in Florida for the last several years.
