Miss A. Elizabeth Leaning

On Saturday, November 12th, 1927, occurred the death of Miss A. Elizabeth Leaning following a brief illness. Miss Leaning was the daughter of Dr. John K. Leaning, long a practicing physician in this locality, and Jane Gross Leaning. Born at Fly Creek, N.Y., April 25, 1851, Miss Leaning was educated at Cooperstown Seminary and Clinton Liberal Institute. Her entire life was devoted to the care of her home. She took a very active interest in the work of the Daughters of the American Revolution, having served as the Regent of Otsego Chapter several terms. For many years she has served as member of the Board of Trustees of the Church of the Messiah [Universalist], at one time filling the office of treasurer.

Miss Leaning is survived by one sister, Mrs. Fanny L. Thompson, of Cooperstown, two nieces, Miss Florence P. Thompson of Brooklyn and Mrs. Albert P. Brogle of Watertown, Mass., and two nephews, Eugene Leaning of Scranton, Pa., and Dr. K. L. Thompson of Jersey City, N. J.

Services were held from her late residence, No. 42 Susquehanna avenue on Monday, November 14th, at 2 p.m., the Rev. George Boorn officiating. Interment was in the family plot in Lakewood cemetery.
