Albion, N. Y., June 6—Ora Lee, aged 77 years, a well known retired [?] residing in Clifton street, this place, dropped dead Monday evening in the barn at his home here. Coroner Leon G. Ogden was summoned and issued a certificate of death from natural causes due to heart failure. Mr. Lee was born in the town of Barre at the farm owned by him in Lee street road, six miles southwest of Albion. He became a potato specialist in farming. Mr. Lee was a member of the A. O. U. W. fraternity; Knowlesville Grange and a charter member of the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church Society of Albion. He retired from active farming eighteen years ago and moved to the home in this village where he died Monday. Two years ago Mr. Lee and his wife, whom he leaves, celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in this village. He also leaves one son, Ora Lee, Jr., of Albion; one daughter, Mrs. Fred C. Humphrey, of Knowlesville and a sister, Mrs. Laura Freeman, of Middleport, N. Y.
