FORT PLAIN

Henry Leiber, one of the best known and most respected of Nelliston's residents, died at the home of his son Floyd in that village at 10 o'clock Monday night, after having been ill for about four weeks from ailments inherent to advanced age. Mr. Leiber was born in the town of Minden 79 years ago and was a son of the late George and Wilhelmina Sharff Leiber. He was one of the few remaining veterans of the Civil war, a member of Klock Post, G.A.R., of this village, in which he always took an active interest, and of the Fort Plain Universalist church. He was a farmer by occupation and for 42 years a resident of the town of Palatine, retiring from active work some six years ago, living since with his son and frequently a visitor at the home of his daughter in Buffalo. Mr. Leiber's survivors are two daughters, Mrs. Katherine Ackerman of St. Johnsville and Mrs. Albert Leiber of Buffalo; one son, Floyd Leiber of Fort Plain; two grandchildren, Miss Leona Ackerman of St. Johnsville and Raymond Leiber of Nelliston.

The funeral, in charge of Klock Post and the Sons of Veterans, was held from the home this afternoon at 2:30, Rev. H. F. [Herbert Frank] Moulton officiating. Interment in the Fort Plain cemetery.
