Lewis Lennecker Jr.

Lewis Lennecker jr. died suddenly about 6 o'clock Thursday evening at his home on Reid street. Mr. Lennecker had not been seriously ill, but had complained of not feeling well for a few days previous to his death, and Thursday evening was about his home as usual when he was suddenly stricken. A physician was called but medical aid was of no avail as he had died almost instantly. He was born in the town of Canajoharie and in early life came to Fort Plain where he had since resided, his occupation being that of carpenter. He was respected and esteemed by a large circle of friends and acquaintances. He was 44 years of age. He is survived by his widow; one daughter, Carmita; his father, Lewis Lennecker sr.; and four brothers, Charles, George and Edward of Fort Plain and Willard of Providence, R.I. A prayer service was held at his home Sunday afternoon at 1:30 and the funeral from the Catharine Nellis Memorial chapel at 2 o'clock, Rev. H. Elmer Gilchrist [minister of the Universalist Church] officiating. The interment was made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
