FREDERICK REMINGTON'S MOTHER DIES

Geneva, March 15.—Mrs. Clara Sackrider Lewis, wife of O. S. Lewis, a hotel man of this city and Watkins [Glen], died Tuesday morning. Mrs. Lewis was born in Canton, St. Lawrence county, N.Y. Dec. 28, 1836. She was twice married. Her first husband was Col. S.[Seth] P. Remington. They had one son, the late Frederick [Frederic C.] Remington, famous painter of Indians and western scenes. Col S. P. Remington died 35 years ago. Nine years later Mrs. Remington married O. S. Lewis, who for a number of years conducted one of the leading hotels at Watkins [Glen]. Mr. and Mrs. Lewis moved to Geneva about ten years ago.

Mrs. Lewis is survived by her husband and one brother, R. H. Sackrider of Canton. There was a service at her late home here yesterday afternoon, and the body was taken to Canton this morning for burial.
