R. E. LINCOLN DIES FROM PARALYSIS
Groton City Man Passes Away at 80 Years, After Several Months' Illness.

Groton City, Jan. 20.—R. Eugene Lincoln, who has been confined to his bed several months as the result of a stroke of paralysis, died at his home Monday morning, aged 80 years. Besides his wife [Grace *Crittenden* Lincoln] he leaves two daughters, Miss Rena Lincoln and Mrs. Nellie Spaulding of Groton, and two sons, Vern and Lee Lincoln of Rochester.

The funeral was held at 1 p.m. yesterday from the home. The Rev. Mr. Ledyard of the Universalist Church of Cortland officiated. Burial was in Cortland Rural Cemetery.
