FORMER CANTON RESIDENT DIES AT BATH SUNDAY

Mrs. Nettie M. Brown Lindley, 78, wife of George E. Lindley and formerly of Canton, died Sunday at her home in Bath.

Mrs. Lindley was born in Chesterville, Ont., Nov. 6, 1878. While an infant, she was adopted by her aunt and uncle, Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Brown. She attended and was graduated from Canton High School.

On Nov. 26, 1902, she was married to George E. Lindley at the Canton Universalist church.

She was a member of the Universalist church of Canton, the O.E.S. and the Rebekahs of Potsdam, and the Kings Daughters of West Potsdam.

Funeral services were held Tuesday at 2 p.m. at the Waldo Funeral home, Bath, with Rev. Robert C. Howland, pastor of the Bath Presbyterian church, officiating. The Rev. Dr. Max A. Kapp of St. Lawrence university officiated at a prayer service Wednesday morning at 11 at the Lawrence Funeral home here. Burial was made in the Fairview Cemetery [in Canton].

Mrs. Lindley's only known survivor is her husband.
