CLARK A. LINTNER

Clark A. Lintner, 77, died unexpectedly Mar. 28, 1947, at 110 South, where he lived. Dr. H. J. Haberer, coroner, said death was due to a heart ailment.

Mr. Lintner was born Oct. 24, 1869 in Fort Plain, son of the late Robert and Mary Lintner. A retired plumber, he had worked for Wicks-Hughes & Co. and the H. J. Brandeles Corporation. Mr. Lintner married Cora [Belle] Moyer, who died July 23, 1907¹. A member of the Universalist Church, Fort Plain, he had lived here 50 years.

He leaves two daughters, Mrs. Merton Duell, Hamilton; Mrs. Harriet Russell, Syracuse; a sister, Mrs. Flora Rebell, Canajoharie; and a grandchild, Frederick Duell, Hamilton.

The body was taken to Kellbach Funeral Home, 321 Genesee, where it will remain until 9 p.m. Sunday. The funeral will be at 3 p.m. Monday at the Catherine Nellis Memorial Chapel, Fort Plain Cemetery.
