Death Removes Erving¹ Lipe At Fort Plain

Fort Plain, Oct. 26—Erving Lipe, 81, a lifelong resident of Fort Plain, died suddenly at noon Saturday. He was born March 24, 1844, in the Town of Minden, son of the late William and Ann House Lipe, and had always been a resident of this town. In politics he was a Democrat, but had never sought office.
