WILLIAM LIPE

Fort Plain, Sept. 17.—William Lipe, aged 67 years, died Saturday afternoon at 3:20 o'clock at his home in this village. He had been a sufferer from cancer for a long period, but had been confined to his bed for a week. Mr. Lipe was born in and has always been a resident of Fort Plain. He was a son of the late William Lipe and Ann House Lipe, one of the oldest families in this section. Mr. Lipe was a man who made friends easily, being of a pleasant disposition, and many will regret his death. He is survived by two brothers and one sister, Irving Lipe, Mahlen [Malen] Lipe and Mrs. Andrew [Alice] Moyer, all of Fort Plain. The funeral will be held at the home on Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert Frank Moulton, D. D., of the Universalist church, officiating. Interment will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
